





REGULATIONS SARDINIA INTERNATIONAL PITCH & PUTT 2024

Art. 1 Rules and Conditions

The game is played according to: the rules of R&A, IPPA, and FIP&P.

- I. Any Specific Competition Conditions for the competition in question.
- II. Any Additional Local Rules and Conditions issued by the Competition Committee.
- III. For all matters not covered by these regulations, the rules approved by the IPPA -International Pitch & Putt Association (unless overridden by local rules) and accepted by the Italian Pitch & Putt Federation shall apply, supplemented by any Local Rules of the hosting Club.
- IV. The number of clubs allowed is a maximum of 3 for players (the putter and two clubs of the player's choice).
- V. The use of a tee is mandatory on grassed teeing areas.
- VI. The game is played in medal format, but if the ball is not holed after 5 strokes, it must be picked up and a score of 6 is recorded.

Art. 2 Game Format

The competition will be played over 54 holes of stroke play:

- Saturday, September 28th: first and second round.
- Sunday, September 29th: final round.

Art. 3 Admission

The competition is reserved for players:

- I. In compliance with the justice regulations of FIP&P or equivalent.
- II. In compliance with the regulations of their respective Federation.
- III. In compliance with any admission conditions indicated in the Specific Competition Conditions for the competition in question.

Art. 4 Registration Terms

The maximum number of participants is set at 120. In case of an excess of entries, the EGA handicap index will be considered as a preferential element, followed by the chronological order of registration.

Foreign players will have registration priority.

Excess players will be placed on the waiting list.

Registrations will be formalized by completing the registration form available on the Florinas Golf club website at <u>www.florinasgolf.it</u> and paying the registration fee online through the same registration form or by bank transfer to the IBAN of the Florinas Golf.

Art. 5 Registration Fee

The registration fee is set at €60 by August 15th, €80 for registrations after that date (preregistration €40 for Florinas Golf Club members and €60 for subsequent registrations). It includes two practice days on September 26th and 27th and the two competition days. The registration fee is reduced to €40 for under 18s.

Art. 6 Order of Play

The order of play will be established as follows: the first and second rounds at the discretion of the competition committee, the third round based on the individual ranking after the first two rounds.

Art. 7 Prizes (in order of assignment and non-cumulative)

The top 5 ranked players will be awarded.

Special prizes for 1st Lady, 1st Junior, 1st Senior, and 1st Master.

Any additional special prizes may be announced to players by the committee.

Art. 8 Ties and Playoffs

In the event of a tie for the first place, an immediate sudden-death playoff will be played on a single hole (decided by the committee); for all other places, the best score over the last 18-36-9-6-3 holes will count. If the tie persists, a draw will be held.

If it is not possible to hold or complete the playoff in the allotted time, the Competition Committee reserves the right to decide on a different method to resolve the tie.

Art. 9 Tournament Committee

The tournament committee will be made public at the host club, along with the local rules and specific and general competition conditions.

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to modify the competition conditions or local rules if necessary.

The organization reserves the right to make any changes necessary for the best conduct of the event.

Art. 10 Complaints

Any complaints must be submitted and justified in writing to the Competition Committee before submitting one's score.
